DONATIONS AND STUDENT ASSISTANCE

JU Alumni Association has student assistance programme that was initiated about 20 years ago. Since then the financial assistance to the needy students is continuing. This provided quarterly stipends of Rs.1500/-, Rs.3000/-, Rs.5000/- during the academic year 2015 - 2016 to over 600 needy and meritorious students, aggregating about Rs.50 Lakh. This may be the largest of its kind by any alumni body across the country.

Funds are being received, mainly from the alumnus of JU & NCE Bengal, many well-wishers and a few corporate bodies, in the form of periodic donations or one-time donations for a permanent source of fund to endow the students. The donors are entitled to indicate preference in respect of recipient's assistance, and to assign a name of their choice to be awarded.

Applications for assistance during the current academic year are being processed, and subsequently selection of 'renewal applicants' and 'fresh applicants' would be carried out in Aug'16 and Sep'16 respectively.

Donations are eligible for exemption of taxes as per section 80G of Indian IT act.
